

NUUO US Inc is pleased to confirm that products marketed to the US Federal, State, and Local Governments, Recipients of Federal Grants or Loans, and Contractors/Affiliates supplying NUUO products for these projects are purchasing products which are in compliance with NDAA Section 889 of the John McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Effective on January 1, 2020).

Section 889 “Prohibits the use of certain telecommunications and video surveillance services or equipment, sub-systems, and components including their affiliates, OEM’s, ODM’s and JDM’s” for use on Governmental Projects or properties which are accepting funding from the Federal Government. This is due to the potential for a cyber security breach as well as crimes against humanity when these products are deployed. The primary source for these products comes from Mainland China (PRC). The current list (subject to change) of banned companies are as follows:

- Hangzhou Hikvision Technology Company
- Dahua Technology Company
- Huawei Hisilicon Technologies Company
- ZTE Corporation
- Hytera Communications Corporation

NUUO US Inc. is committed to source NDAA compliant chipsets (Microprocessors, SOC, and Image Sensors) from known vendors. These include but are not limited to:

- Intel
- AMD
- Sony
- MStar
- Ambarella

Furthermore, NUUO US Inc. is in compliance with the Trade Agreements Act (TAA 19 U.S.C. & 2501-2581) which stipulates only countries found on this Federal list have agreed to “Fair and Open International Trade Practices.” NUUO US Inc. uses TAA compliant products and subsystems manufactured in the United States, South Korea (ROC), Japan, and Taiwan.

Lastly, on March 4, 2022, the Governor of the State of California, Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-6-22 (EO) regarding sanctions in response to Russian aggression in Ukraine. The EO directs all contractors to use goods manufactured in compliance with existing economic sanctions imposed by the U.S. Government in response to Russia’s actions in Ukraine, as well as any sanctions imposed under state law. NUUO US Inc. is in full compliance with this Executive Order and will continue to do so until such time the EO is rescinded.
